

Academic Time table is prepared at the start of every semester with the course name and the name of the faculty handling the course. To facilitate the students with English communication skills, Communication Classes

are incorporated into the regular time table and are handled by the faculty members of the Institute. The time table is shared with the students and faculty at the start of the semester itself.

- Teaching load of each faculty:
- The subject allocation of the faculty is carried out based on the area of specialization of the faculty members in a democratic manner and the work load for the term is also discussed and decided in the faculty meeting.
- Internal continuous evaluation system in place
- In order to facilitate continuous assessment of the students, three internal tests and one model examination are conducted at regular interval in each semester. The Students are internally evaluated for 25 marks on the basis of their test performance, Class participation, Assignments and Seminars done by the students. The same is communicated to the students also.
- Students' assessment of Faculty, system in place
- The Institute follows a systematic feedback management system, wherein the feedback about the Faculty, Course, Special Programs organized are collected form the students. The subject knowledge of the faculty, their punctuality to the classes, skills in student engagement, completion of the syllabus on time, providing motivation and guidance to the students are obtained as students feedback every semester. Further the Institute organizes Guest Lectures to facilitate practical exposure of the students. Feedback is also collected regarding the Guest Speaker, the relevance of the topic, their presentation and suggestions for further sessions.
- Each course faculty regularly collects oral feedback from the students about their course both during the start of the course as well as intermittently during the delivery of the course.
- Institute has a well structured feedback form which covers all the relevant aspects of faculty members such as depth of the course content delivered by the faculty members, communication skills, applicability / relevance to management issues of the content delivered etc. The feedback form is circulated amongst the students annually and feedback is collected from them maintaining confidentiality. The collected feedbacks are then collated and analyzed to generate report and invite suggestions for improvements and measures are taken subsequently.
